- **Grammar: Past Simple.**

- We use past simple to talk about actions that starts and ends in the past.
- We use verbs in past to write affirmative sentences in past simple.
- Regular verbs are those that only need –d or –ed to became past simple.
- Those verbs that end with –e only need –d to be past, and those that end with any other letter need –ed to be past.

- E.g.: Need → Needed
 Decide → Decided

- Affirmative Form:

S+ Verb in Past+ C

E.g.: She *lived* in Australia last year.
 The pirate *discovered* a treasure.
 They *escaped* from prison yesterday.
